



INTERNSHIP (INT)

INT 297 Summer Internship (3 Credits)

The Summer Internship course is a structured work experience during which students will gain practical experience related to their program of study and career goals. Students work with the internship supervisor to develop specific goals and a plan to achieve the required course objectives. The internship includes experiences related to industry-specific skills as well as soft skills needed in the workplace, such as problem-solving, work ethic, and leadership. The student will have weekly class discussion with the designated UTTC internship supervisor/facilitator. Students will complete 24 hours per week for 7 weeks in their 3 credit internship placement. The course culminates with a performance evaluations by the employer and the internship supervisor. Students must have completed a minimum of two fulltime semesters at UTTC or have the transfer equivalent to register for this course.

Prerequisite: Students must have completed a minimum of two full-time semesters at UTTC, or have the transfer equivalent, to register for this course.
